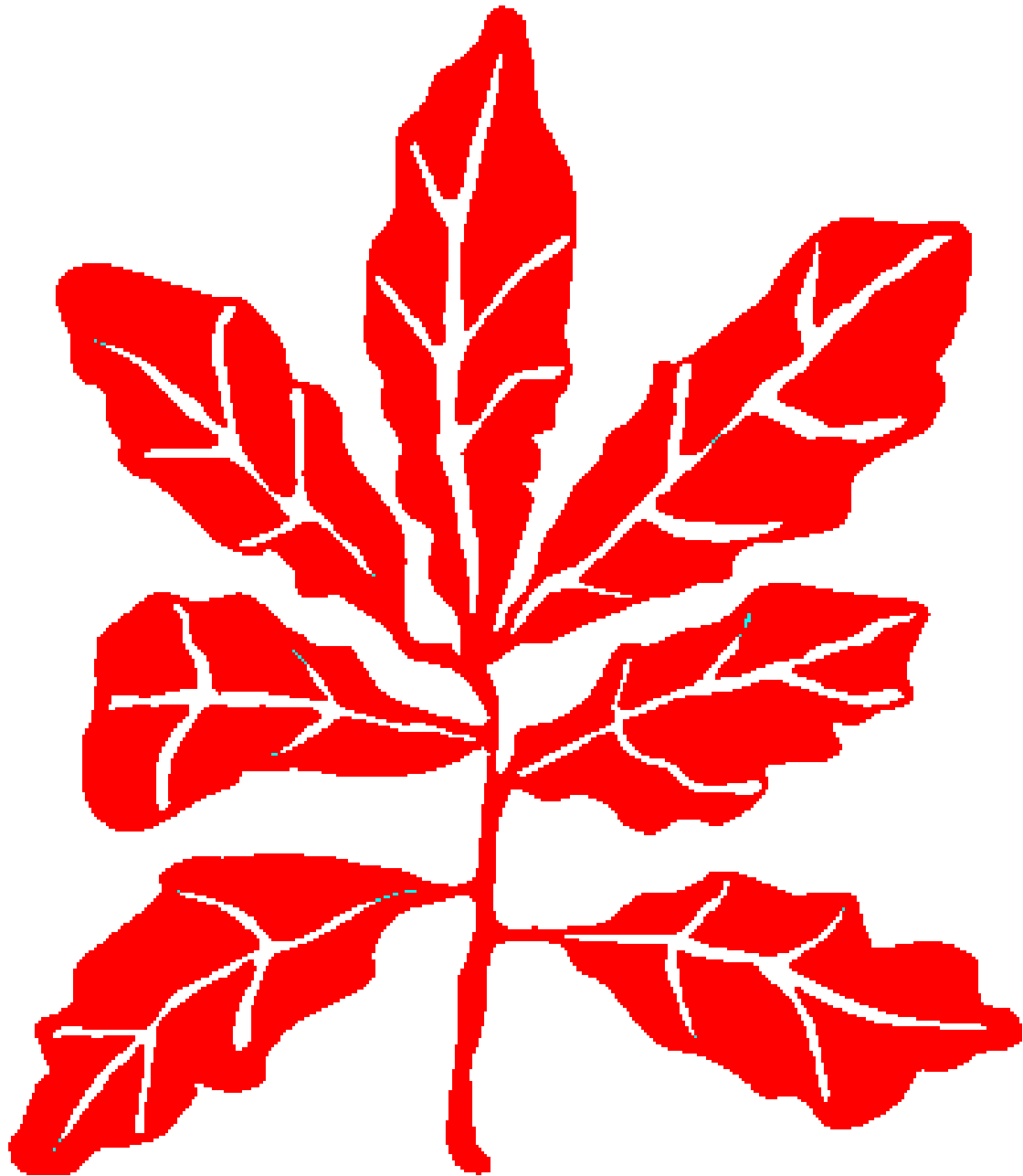


Sevenoaks School Old Sennockian

The Alex Polyviou Memorial Player of the Tournament

Alex was an old Sennockian. He started in the junior school in 1994 and was a 2001 leaver. During his Sevenoaks years Alex, as a talented footballer, was very much part of the school football teams including representing the first XI in the sixth form.

He was a very competitive guy, playing with passion and not always an easy competitor to face. But a gentleman off the pitch. Post-Sevenoaks Alex played in the OS 5-a-side for many years under Alex Smith's tenure as OS lead and our 2001 leavers won the original tournament in 2010. He also played for the OS 11 a side team in their first year.

Alex was a life-long Millwall fan and a regular visitor to their games in SE London. He also had a very successful career in Insurance with Lloyds. He was married to Laura and had 2 children, Raphael and Lola.

Alex was diagnosed with a very advanced and rare form of cancer in late 2022 and died early in 2023. As he was a fierce competitor, but a great friend and a really nice guy, some of the younger OS knew him through professional networks.

We wanted to commission a cup for the player's player of the tournament in his memory. Awarded to someone who played well, competed hard and respected the tradition of the tournament and its location.



Orange for Alfie

On Saturday 28th March we are going Orange for Alfie to raise money for the Lullaby Trust as part of a special fundraising day to remember Lauren's son Alfie, who tragically passed away in February 2025.

Alfie was a little red head (hence the orange theme), so in his memory, the staff and students will be encouraged to wear orange items of clothing as part of their sports clothing to make a colourful tribute to Alfie.

General Information

- Rolling subs may be allowed.
- All of the laws are mentioned later in the programme.
- 3 points for a win and 1 point for a draw.
- Parking will be in the Dukes Meadow car park opposite the school as shown on the map.
- Shinpads should be worn and a Futsal ball/Futsal Goals will be used. Bibs will be provided to the first team listed should there be a clash with kit.
- First Aid will be available from the Registration point and toilets can found around the centre.
- Lost Property – Please contact the reception in the Sennocke Centre for any lost and found.
- Markings – Blue pitch. Penalties to be taken from the green line.



Sevenoaks Futsal Rules/Laws:

N.B. Aside from laws below, normal football rules apply.

- Winner of a one round game of rock, paper, scissors will have a kick off from centre spot. Opposition team must stand behind blue line across pitch.
- Overhead height is permitted but keeper cannot throw beyond the half way line (black line) without it bouncing or touching any player in their own half. Indirect free kick from half way line for infringement.
- Rolling subs during break in play.
- The dimensions of the pitch are the blue lines. Penalties from the green line.
- If the ball goes over the end lines then a goal kick or corner will be awarded. Corners will be taken normally rather than rolled in but you cannot score directly from the corner unless it touches an opponent. Keepers must throw out even when goal kick is awarded.
- If the ball goes out at the side then a kick in will be taken instead of a throw in but you cannot score directly.
- All players and subs will stand to the outside wall side of the pitch.
- All players can enter the penalty areas and can shoot from inside.
- No sliding tackles.
- Defenders must be at least 3 metres away from free kicks and kick in's.
- The keeper can come out of the area but if they accidentally handle outside of the penalty area then indirect free kick.
- Pass backs are allowed to the keeper but they cannot pick the ball up. Indirect freekick from the edge of the area.
